WHAT TO EXPECT

EVERYONE IS WELCOME

No matter what service you attend, you will experience high-energy, contemporary and spontaneous worship. You will feel the love of Christ through our people in an inviting atmosphere and receive Bible -based teaching that is relevant and powerful.

MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

Mentoring and Leadership Development: We are passionate about raising up leaders in the Body of Christ in general, and in GFC in particular. Our efforts in doing so include offering classes and course curriculum for the general congregation to participate in. However, we also prayerfully seek to personally mentor leaders in whom we recognize the proper gifting and ability to enable them to play a greater leadership role in our church. Our efforts to mentor potential leaders are reserved for those who are formal members only.

Accountability: Accountable relationships and protection from "wolves" (Acts 20:28-32). Our aim in maintaining accountable relationships with formal members is intended to ensure that they mature in their spiritual formation; discover, develop and exercise their spiritual gifts; and receive the oversight to guide that process. In addition, while we are always watchful of the "wolves" that may threaten all the sheep in general, we can only do so strategically with those with whom we are in accountable relationship. These are primarily those who have formalized their membership at GFC.

Communication: Sharing information concerning the direction of the church and the decisions made by our Board of Elders will be communicated in the following sequence: First, our Leadership Team will be notified; then our formal Members and lastly, the general congregation. As a result of your commitment to GFC, we feel it proper that formal members become aware of decisions being made as to the church's advancement.

We understand the clear teaching of the Scriptures which states that in order to enjoy the benefits of church membership, one must first bear the responsibilities of church membership. This is the basis of Covenantal Relationship, as stated in the Membership Covenant of Grace Fellowship Church.

MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

As a Covenant Member of Grace Fellowship Church, we have a responsibility to ensure that a certain level of care and oversight is extended to those who are part of our "household of faith" (Gal. 6:10; 1 Tim. 5:8): These include:

Shepherding: While we are passionate about shepherding all of God's flock, we consider formal members our first priority in extending pastoral care or support. As formal "family" members, this group represents our "Jerusalem" and first area targeted for ministry. Afterwards, we can extend this to other attendees of GFC as resources of personnel and time permit.

Benevolence: Requests for benevolence or financial assistance will be considered for members of GFC who are regular tithers. The biblical precedent of benefits extending to those who faithfully support the ministry with their finances is key here. (2 Thess. 3:10) Requests for benevolence by regular attenders who are non-members will be considered thereafter. Benevolence is not available to others for whom GFC is not their home church.

Spiritual Guidance: Spiritual Guidance is a ministry that is provided to formal members of GFC and may be extended to regular attendees, as resources and personnel permit.

Weddings, Funerals, Baptisms will be performed and provided to formal members of GFC. From time to time, requests for such services may come from non-members. These will be considered by the Elders on an exceptional basis and handled accordingly.

Hospital Visitation: While we will assign a member of our visitation team to anyone we are aware that has undergone hospital care, we will make assignments to members first, then others as personnel are available.

OUR MISSION

"Loving God and Loving People."

Our mission is to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength and to love other people as ourselves. (Mark 12:28-31) Loving God is expressed through faith, obedience and passionate worship. Loving others is expressed through acceptance, forgiveness, and doing what's best for them.

WHAT WE BELIEVE

What we believe about God:

We believe that there is one true and living God who created and sustains all things. He is eternally existent in three Persons who are one in nature, purpose, and attributes and who are worthy of the same worship and obedience. (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19)

God is all-powerful, all-knowing, omnipresent and eternal. God is unchanging. He is holy, righteous, just and merciful. God is spirit. God is love. (1 John 4:16)

God desires to have a personal relationship with us. Sin broke fellowship with God, but He loves us so much that He gave His only begotten son in order to restore our relationship with Him. (John 3:16)

What we believe about man:

To be born again, we must repent of our sins, place our faith in the finished work of Jesus Christ and confess Jesus as Lord. Salvation is by grace, through faith, not of works. There is no other way to be saved apart from Jesus Christ. (John 14:6; Acts 4:16; Romans 10:9-13)

What we believe about Church:

The Bible teaches several baptisms. Baptism into the Body of Christ occurs at salvation. Water baptism is by immersion. The baptism in the Holy Spirit is subsequent to salvation. The baptism of the fire is the ongoing purification process of believers. (Matthew 3:11; Acts 2:38)
