Knowing God Series

"GOD IS IMMUTABLE" (Mal. 3:6)

INTRODUCTION:

Malachi 3:6a (NLT)

- 6 "I am the Lord, and I do not change. ...
 - In this verse, the Lord declares His Name as:
 - Jehovah = the Self-Existent, Eternal One

NOTE:

God is never revealed in the bible in a DRY, PURELY THEOLOGICAL WAY

- He is almost always revealed in some DIMENSION of His CHARACTER and NATURE
- Usually woven out of some ACT of His; and demonstration of HIS NATURE.
- In CONTEXT of His PROMISES or COMMANDMENTS
- HE NEVER CHANGES

I. PRACTICAL CONSIDERATIONS OF GOD'S IMMUTABILITY:

But the **unchangeableness** of God is:

- the denial of all imperfection,
- the denial of all dependence on circumstances,
- the denial of all possibility of decay or exhaustion,
- the denial of all inconsistency.
- the assurance that His is an underived, self-dependent being, and that with Him is the fountain of light;
- the assurance that, above the limits of time and the succession of events, He is in the **eternal present**, where all things that were and are, and are to come, stand naked and open.

NOTE:

THIS IS A DIFFICULT CONCEPT FOR OUR FINITE MINDS TO UNDERSTAND COMPLETELY.

EL OLAM = THE GOD OF ETERNITY (PLACE OF NO TIME!)

Psalm 90:2 (NKJV)

Before the mountains were brought forth,
Or ever You had formed the earth and the world, **Even from everlasting to everlasting**, You are God.

Isaiah 40:28 (NLT)

Have you never heard?

Have you never understood?

The Lord is the *everlasting God*,

the *Creator* of all the earth.

He never grows weak or weary.

No one can measure the depths of his understanding.

AS CREATOR:

- External circumstances cannot exert any influence on Him.
- If He became SUBJECT to any circumstances, He would CEASE TO BE OMNIPOTENT
- If CULTURAL MORES or PHILOSOPHIES exerted any influence on Him, He would CEASE TO BE OMNICIENT!
- It is IMPOSSIBLE for the ONE who Created ALL things to be subject to anything He created!
- The EVERLASTING GOD cannot ever change Himself, nor can ANYTHING OR ANYONE ELSE CHANGE HIM!

HE IS ABSOLUTE PERFECTION

NOTE:

THERE IS NO DIFFERNCE BETWEEN THE GOD OF THE OLD TESTAMENT AND THE GOD OF THE NEW TESTAMENT! HE IS THE SAME! OUR EXPERIENCE OF HIM IS PURELY A RESULT OF THE MINISTRY OF THE MEDIATOR BETWEEN GOD AND MANKIND – JESUS CHRIST! BE CAREFUL HOW YOU OR OTHERS CHARACTERIZE HIM!

II. THE IMPACT OF GOD'S IMMUTABILITY ON OUR LIVES:

- My AIM is not only to list the CONCEPT of God's IMMUTABILITY
- Need to be PRACTICAL and EQUIPPING for us.

NOTE:

THIS IS PERHAPS THE MOST IMPORTANT THING TO UNDERSTAND ABOUT KNOWING GOD AND WALKING IN HIS WAYS!

- GOD'S WAYS DON'T CHANGE
- GOD'S WORD DOESN'T CHANGE
- HIS METHODS ARE INNUMERABLE

QUESTION:

SO THEN WHY DO SO MANY PEOPLE MAINTAIN SUCH DIFFERENT AND DIVERGENT VIEWS OF GOD? (IF HE IS UNCHANGABLE)

ILLUSTRATION: Downloading the right diver.

- Most of us have had the experience of DOWNLOADING A NEW PRINTER on our computer
- We need to DOWNLOAD the right DRIVER so the printer will work as

- designed; performing all the functions its designer intended it to.
- Without the RIGHT DRIVER, certain features will not function, it may not work at all!

ANSWER:

SOME PEOPLE DON'T HAVE THE RIGHT "DRIVER" INSTALLED IN THEIR HEARTS! THAT IS THE REASON FOR SO MANY DIFFERENT AND DIVERGENT VIEWS OF GOD – THEY CANNOT ALL BE RIGHT!

WHAT IS OUR "DRIVER"?
THE CONDITION OF OUR "HEARTS" TOWARD GOD!

A "PURE" HEART = not a sinless, perfect heart; but an UNDIVIDED heart.

A pure heart is a heart with ONE, SINGULAR, LOYALTY and a LIFESTYLE that demonstrates it.

A 'DIVIDED' HEART = a heart with many loyalties; shifting due to internal and external pressures and circumstances.

Scripture References:

Psalm 51:10 (NLT)
Create in me a clean heart, O God.
Renew a loyal spirit within me.

Psalm 86:11 (NLT)
Teach me your ways, O Lord,
that I may live according to your truth!
Grant me purity of heart,
so that I may honor you.

Matthew 5:8 (NLT)

God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God.

NOTE:

TO THE OBEDIENT WITH AN UNDIVIDED HEART, THE IMMUTABILITY OF GOD IS A BLESSSING. TO THE DISOBEDIENT WITH DIVIDED LOYALTIES, IT IS A STUMBLINGBLOCK AND A CURSE.

III. TWO BIBLICAL EXAMPLES: DAVID AND SAUL BEFORE GOLIATH:

DAVID – an undivided heart

• KING SAUL – a man of divided heart

David = a shepherd boy going to bring provisions to his brothers in Saul's army

Saul = the King of Israel (her first earthly king)

Their BEHAVIOR gives EVIDENCE to the HEART they maintained toward GOD!

Acts 13:22 (NLT)

22 But God removed Saul and replaced him with David, a man about whom God said, *'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart. He will do everything I want him to do.'*

DAVID: THE UNDIVIDED HEART

1 Samuel 17:37 (NLT)

The Lord who rescued me from the claws of the lion and the bear will rescue me from this Philistine!" (ELABORATE)

POINTS:

- THE GOD YOU TRUSTED TO DEFEND YOU IN THE PAST DOESN'T'
 CHANGE BECAUSE THE PROBLEM GETS BIGGER
- THE GOD WHO DEFENDED AND PROTECTED YOU IN PRIVATE WILL ALSO PROTECT AND DEFEND YOU IN PUBLIC
- THE GOD WHO USED YOU THE WAY YOU WERE IN THE PAST WILL USE YOU THE WAY YOU ARE IN THE PRESENT ("I CAN'T USE THESE..." v39)
 - The most LIBERATING and FAITH-FILLED words of a man who knows GOD NEVER CHANGES
 - THERE WILL BE TIME FOR GROWTH, IMPROVEMENT AND ARMOR (HIS OWN)
 - GOD WANTS TO USE HIS DAVIDS THE WAY THEY ARE; WITH WHAT THEY CAN DO; AND WITH WHAT THEY KNOW NOW!
- THE UNDIVIDED HEART SEES GOD BIGGER THAN HIS PROBLEMS

1 Samuel 17:46 (NLT)

Today *the Lord* will conquer you, and *I will kill you* and cut off your head. And then I will give the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel!

KING SAUL: THE DIVIDED HEART

1 Samuel 13:12 (NLT)

So I said, 'The Philistines are ready to march against us at Gilgal, and I haven't even asked for the Lord's help!' So I felt compelled to offer the burnt offering myself before you came." (ELABORATE)

- Overwhelming circumstances: 3,000 chariots, 6,000 charioteers
- Samuel instructed Saul to wait for him to arrive to sacrifice before going to battle.

Saul waited 7 days, then offered the sacrifice himself; afterwards,
 Samuel arrived

POINTS:

- (v8) HE LET CIRCUMSTANCES PUSH HIM INTO DISOBEDIENCE (AS IF GOD HAD CHANGED HIS PROMISE THROUGH SAMUEL!
 - HE SAW "HIS TROOPS" SLIPPING AWAY (I guess he forgot Gideon)
 - PRIDE and SELF-WILL signifies a LOYALTY to HIMSELF rather than God
- (v11) The DIVIDED HEART ALWAYS PLAYS THE "BLAME GAME" TO JUSTFIY SELF-WILL (PRIDE) "... YOU DIDN'T COME WHEN YOU WERE SUPPOSED TO..."
- (v12) The DIVIDED HEART will always try to sound "spiritual" as a cover for disobedience. "The armies were ready to march and I hadn't even sacrificed to the Lord yet."
- (v13) THE DIVIDED HEART DOESN'T UNDERSTAND THAT 99% OBEDIENCE IS STILL DISOBEDIENCE!

1 Samuel 13:13 (NLT)

13 "How foolish!" Samuel exclaimed. "You have not kept the command the Lord your God gave you. Had you kept it, the Lord would have established your kingdom over Israel forever.

NOTE:

GOD NEVER CHANGES. HIS PLANS AND PURPOSES NEVER CHANGE.
HOWEVER, OUR USEFULNESS IN HIS HAND AND HIS PLAN CHANGE AS A
RESULT OF THE CONDITION OF OUR HEARTS!

ONE CLOSING THOUGHT:

Between Malachi 3:6 (The last book in scripture to the Jewish People in OT) and

Hebrews 13:8 (the Only book directed to the Jewish people in NT)

THERE WERE 400 YEARS OF SILENCE!

NOTE:

IT DOESN'T MATTER IS YOU HAVEN'T HEARD THE VOICE OF GOD OVER A LONG PERIOD OF SILENCE. REST ASSURED THAT BETWEEN THE LAST TIME YOU HEARD HIM AND NOW, HE HASN'T CHANGED!

THE GOD WHO NEVER CHANGES IN MALACHI IS THE "SAME, YESTERDAY, TODAY AND FOREVER...RIGHT NOW!

PRAYER:

- GOD NEVER CHANGES, BUT OUR HEARTS MUST
- PRAYER FOR AN UNDIVIDED HEART
- REPENT FOR HAVING A DIVIDED HEART
 - Playing the BLAME game
 - Playing the RELIGIOUS game
 - o Letting circumstances push you into disobedience
 - Letting emotions push you into disobedience
